

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)		£2040.00
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Collecting and transporting the deceased persons from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care		£195
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises at 45 Norton Road, Stockton on Tees TS18 2BU		£196
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from veneered oak, lined and fitted with handles		£299
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)		£5
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle		£350

UNATTENDED FUNERAL	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1034
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) (see note 2)	£1499
FEES YOU MUST PAY	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee is (see note 1 and note 3) In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee is:	£550-£900 £550
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES	
This funeral director can supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or can arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:	
Additional mileage (price per mile outside the Teesside area)	£1

note 1	This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for re-opening and closing an existing grave
note 2	In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates of Cremation.
note 3	For non-residents, the burial fees may be higher and additional charges may apply
